

Walk-in-interview will be conducted on 12 November 2018 (Monday) at 11:00 am in the second floor of the Platinum Jubilee Building for the recruitment of one Project linked person purely on temporary basis to work in the ISI funded project titled “Archean Greenstone belts in India – tectonics and sedimentation” in the Geological Studies Unit of the Indian Statistical Institute, Kolkata.

- Qualifications : Essential: A first class M.Sc. degree in Geology/ Applied Geology or equivalent (minimum of 55% marks or B+ or equivalent grade in previous degree) with sound background in petrology/ geochemistry and/or structural geology, with aptitude for geological field work.
- Desirable: UGC-CSIR NET (JRF) qualified; proficiency in use of common applications software for earth sciences.
