**Instructions to Download the Admit Card**

1. Click the [link](#) to download the admit card.
2. Use the registration number (generated during application process) and the date of birth to login.
3. Select Hall Ticket tab after login.
4. Choose Assessment as ISI Recruitment 13<sup>th</sup> January 2019.
5. Click on Search.
6. In the next row, under Action, Download option will appear.
7. Select Download to receive the admit card.

**Instructions to the Candidate**

1. **Print this Admit Card** on an A4 size paper using a printer. Admit Card is valid only if the Candidate affixes a recent passport size, colour photograph with white background.
2. Candidate must produce the Admit Card for verification at the time of the test along with an original photo ID (Driving License / Passport / PAN Card / Voter ID / Aadhaar Card). The candidate should also attach a self-attested photocopy of this photo ID card with the printed Admit Card and submit to the respective invigilator.
3. The candidate's name on the photo ID should match the exact name on the Admit Card. The photo ID card should not be damaged or smudged. Candidate failing to bring original photo ID card will not be allowed to appear for the test.
4. Candidates should report at their **respective test center earliest at 12:30 pm and not later than 1:30 pm**. No candidate will be allowed inside the test center after 1:30 pm.

5. Candidates are advised to locate their test center and its accessibility at least a day before the test so that they can reach the center on time on the day of the test. The google map link embedded on the electronic version of the Admit card may be of particular help to locate the test center.
6. **Only Admit Card**, photo ID Card and self-attested photocopy of photo ID card will be allowed inside the Test Hall.
7. Mobile phones, pen, cap / hat, electronic gadgets, watches, calculators, stationery items, papers, wallets, goggles, jackets and any jewelry or items containing metal will **NOT BE ALLOWED** inside the Test Hall. Plain sweater / cardigan / pullover without pockets will be allowed.
8. We do not guarantee safekeeping of your personal belongings outside the test hall and test conducting authority is not responsible for their damage or loss, if any.
9. Pen and paper for rough work will be supplied at the test centre.
10. Friends and relatives accompanying the Candidates will not be allowed inside the test center.
11. Candidate will undergo security check such as frisking before entering the test lab. Non-cooperation with the same will result in barring from appearing for the test. Any prohibited item found during frisking will have to be left behind.
12. Candidates have to undergo mandatory biometric and photograph capture activity before start of the test.
13. Candidates need to make their own travel and stay arrangements for attending the Test.
14. The Admit Card is provisional, subject to the condition that the candidate has fulfilled the eligibility conditions like academic qualification, category, PwD status, etc., as mentioned in his/her Application, which is subject to verification in the consecutive stages of the selection process.
15. Request for change of test center will **NOT** be entertained.
16. The Admit Card and self-attested photocopy of photo ID card will be collected by the invigilator. Candidates should not leave the test center before submitting their respective Admit Card and self-attested photocopy of the photo ID card.
