1. As announced earlier, withdrawal of nominations, if any, should be communicated in writing by the candidate concerned to the undersigned by 4-00 p.m. of 30th September, 2020.
2. Elections, where necessary, will be held on 5th and 6th November, 2020 in the outlying Centres/Branches/Offices/Units and on 18th and 19th November, 2020 in the Headquarters at Baranagar.
3. Booth(s) will be erected in Baranagar Campus of the Institute for voters attached to the Headquarters at Baranagar to enable voters to cast their votes personally by ballot.
4. For outlying Centres/Branches/Offices/Units etc., election papers, including ballot papers, where necessary, will be sent by speed post well in advance so that the voters, after completing all formalities, can send back, duly cast and completed ballot papers, to the undersigned through the respective Heads of outlying Centres / Branches / Offices / Units etc. so as to reach the office of the Election Officer on or before 19th November, 2020 (up to 4-00 p.m.). A voter of such outstation centre may, at his own risk and responsibility, after collection of necessary

ballot papers from the respective Heads, may send the duly cast/completed ballot papers directly so as to reach the undersigned on or before, 19th November, 2020 (up to 4-00 p.m.).

5. It is also decided that the Election will be held on 5th November, 2020 & 6th November, 2020 from 11:30 a.m to 03:30 p.m at the Outlying Centres/Units/ Sections/Branches etc. In Headquarters at Kolkata election will be held on 18th November, 2020 & 19th November, 2020 from 11:30 a.m. to 03:30 p.m, the voters may have their option to franchise their rights accordingly keeping in mind social distancing norm due to COVID-19 Corona Virus, Attached Form-6 (for Headquarters) & 6A (for Centres) may also be used for postal voting in case the voter are willing to cast their votes through postal ballots. The Form may be downloaded from the Institute website for seeking ballot in advance for casting votes. The Institute authority shall not be held responsible for any type of postal delay.

Guidelines for voters of outlying Centres/Offices etc. regarding polling by ballot in connection with Election 2020-2022 of one representative of Scientific workers of the Institute to the Council are being sent under a separate circular.
