**Sub: Announcement of the recruitment process of the following posts against recruitment
Advertisement No. REC-7/2019-3, Kol dated 03.08.2019**

• **Cook-A**

1. The selection test for recruitment against the above-mentioned posts will be conducted in **two stages**.

Stage-I : An **Offline MCQ Based Test** of one (1) hour duration for shortlisting of candidates will be held purely on the subject knowledge.

Stage-II : **Trade/ Skill Test** - Candidates shortlisted in Stage-I have to appear in **Trade/Skill Test (offline) which is only qualifying in nature** i.e., candidates have to obtain a minimum qualifying marks to be considered for final empanelment.

Note : Candidates qualified in Trade Test will be finally shortlisted in order of merit based on marks obtained by them in Stage-I only.

2. **Qualifying marks** for various categories in the above two stages are detailed in **Table-A** below.

3. Details of MCQ based test (Stage-I):

- Candidates will be asked to answer **25 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)** in **60 minutes**. Full marks: 100.
- For all the questions there will be four choices, one of which is the correct answer. Each question answered correctly will be awarded 4 marks. A question not answered or wrongly answered will be awarded zero (0) mark.
- Any overwriting or double marking of answers will be treated as **NOT Answered**.

4. Details of Skill Test (Stage-II): This will be a practical examination in the field of cooking to test practical knowledge & technical skills of the candidates. Full marks: 100.

5. Selection criterion for Cook-A


6. Ties at any stage will be resolved in the following two levels one after another, if necessary.

a. Level-1: The ratio between the number of correct answers (s) and number of incorrect/ un-attempted answer(s) in the MCQ Test will be considered. The candidates obtaining higher ratio will be given higher rank.

b. Level-2: If there are still ties after Level-1, then a candidate with higher experience will be given higher rank.
