

# NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANTS SEEKING WAIVER FROM WRITTEN TESTS AS INMO AWARDEES

Dear Applicant,

Greetings from the INDIAN STATISTICAL INSTITUTE!

It is noted from your application for the ISI Admission Test 2018, scheduled to be held on Sunday, the 13th of May, 2018, that you have identified yourself to be an INMO awardee.

Please note that, in this respect, the ISI Prospectus for 2018-19 says:

*The written test is waived for applicants who have been selected as INMO AWARDEES to participate in the International Mathematics Olympiad Training Camp (IMOTC) in the current year or in any previous year, based on their performance in the Indian National Mathematics Olympiad (INMO) conducted by the National Board of Higher Mathematics, Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India. Such candidates will be directly called for interviews.*

*However, like all other candidates, such candidates are also required to apply in the prescribed application form for admission to the programme. Merely holding an INMO Certificate of Merit from Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE) or clearing any Math Olympiad organised by any other organisation will not suffice for waiver of written tests for selection to the programme.*

Since there are too many Mathematics Olympiads being held nowadays, we need to ascertain that you are actually an INMO AWARDEE in the above sense to qualify for the waiver.

Hence, you are requested to send scanned copies of relevant supporting document(s), namely,

- INMO AWARD CERTIFICATE, and/ or
- your letter of invitation to the IMOTC

to [admissionsupport@isical.ac.in](mailto:admissionsupport@isical.ac.in) with copy to [dean@isical.ac.in](mailto:dean@isical.ac.in) positively on or before April 27, 2018. The subject of the email should be: Written Test Waiver for INMO Awardees.


PLEASE DO NOT FORGET TO MENTION YOUR REGISTRATION NO. IN YOUR E-MAIL.
