POLICY REGARDING COVID-19 POSITIVE/SYMPTOMATIC CANDIDATES

1. Regarding Candidates who have tested positive for COVID-19 on or after September 10, 2020

Such candidates are advised to complete the self-isolation/quarantine prescribed by MoHFW in its Guidelines, even if they are not symptomatic. They should not make any attempt to violate the same by arriving at the designated Test Centre to appear for the Admission Test.

2. Regarding Candidates who are high-risk or exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 on the day of the Test

Any candidate for whom the following is/are noted at the point of entry of the designated Test Centre will not be allowed to appear for the Admission Test, in the interest of the safety of other candidates and Centre personnel:

- (a) When checked with Thermo gun, the observed temperature is greater than 99°F.
- (b) The candidate has ticked ANY of the boxes under point no. 2 of the COVID-related Undertaking appended to the Forenoon Admit Card, OTHER THAN the box for sub-item (c).
