NOTICE

In partial modification of the Notice issued on May 19, 2020, it is hereby intimated to all registered candidates of the ISI Admission Test 2020, that:

- The ISI Admission Test 2020, which had earlier been rescheduled to August 02, 2020, is **postponed**. In view of the uncertainty prevailing on account of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, it is not possible to declare a firm date for the Test at this time, but it is not expected to be held before the second week of September 2020. Announcement of the exact date will be made after proper assessment of the situation, bearing in mind the well-being and safety of the candidates, and ensuring that they are able to appear for the Test without any risk or hardship. Candidates will be duly notified of the new date for the Admission Test well in advance.
- As soon as the date is announced, all registered candidates will be provided a small window for making changes in their centre preferences and uploading pending documents like results of qualifying examination (if appeared in 2020), and those related to reservation category (OBC-NCL/SC/ST/PwD), GATE and INMO, by logging into their accounts on the online Application portal.
- Admit cards will be issued soon after this window closes. We will try our best to ensure that this is done at least three weeks before the new Admission Test date.
- Relevant dates will be announced through the [ISI Admission webpage](#). Candidates are requested to keep a close watch on this webpage.
- The [Revised Selection Policy](#) will be in force unless modified further due to changing circumstances, in which case appropriate announcements will be made.
- Owing to logistic constraints or unavoidable issues,
 - some candidates may have to be allocated to the centre of their second preference due to merger of a few centres with those close to them. The revised list of centres will be announced before Admit Cards are issued;
 - it may not be possible for ISI to entertain requests for refund of application fee on account of rescheduling of the Admission Test.
