

POLICY (REVISED)¹ OF WAIVER OF WRITTEN TESTS FOR ADMISSION 2021-2022

Applicants to B Stat and B Math programmes who are INMO awardees

The written test is waived for applicants who have been selected as INMO AWARDEES to participate in the International Mathematics Olympiad Training Camp (IMOTC) in the current year or in any previous year, based on their performance in the Indian National Mathematics Olympiad (INMO) conducted by the National Board of Higher Mathematics, Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India. Such candidates are generally called directly for interviews. However, for admission in 2021, interviews will not be conducted for applicants eligible for written test waiver and they will be directly offered a rank in the Final Rank-Ordered Merit List. Like all other candidates, such candidates are also required to apply in the prescribed online application form for admission to the programme. Merely holding an INMO Certificate of Merit from Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE) or clearing any Math Olympiad organized by any other organization will not suffice for waiver of written tests for selection to the programme.

Applicants to M Tech (CS) and M Tech (CrS) programmes with valid GATE scores

The written test is waived for applicants to M Tech. (CS) and M Tech (CrS) programmes with a valid GATE score 760 (out of 1000) or above. The qualifying score for OBC is 684 and the qualifying score for SC/ST/PwD is 532. An applicant who applies for admission and meets the announced threshold for GATE score is assigned an equivalent score in the written test based on the GATE score and is generally called directly for the interview. However, for admission in 2021, interviews will not be conducted for applicants eligible for written test waiver and they will be directly offered a rank in the Final Rank-Ordered Merit List based on equivalent scores compared from their individual GATE scores. These candidates are required to apply, like all other candidates, in the prescribed application form.

Applicants to JRF Programmes holding a master's degree from ISI

In the previous years, the written test was waived in respect of qualifying applicants who had obtained a Master's degree in the relevant discipline from the Indian Statistical Institute. Pursuant to a recent decision of the Academic Council of the Institute, **there will be no such waiver in the 2021-2022 admission tests.**
