

PGDBA Admission Test 2017

Instructions for Written Test:

1. Date of Written Test: February 19, 2017 (Sunday).
2. Duration of Test is 3 hours: 10:30 A.M. - 01:30 P.M.
3. Reporting Time: 10:00 A.M.
4. Late Arrival to the Examination Hall: **Candidates will be allowed up to 30 minutes from the start of the test (i.e. up to 11 A.M.).**
5. **Candidates can leave the hall 30 minutes before the end of the Test.**
6. **Mobile phones, calculators, books, charts, graph sheets, tables or any other communication and/or computing devices are strictly prohibited in the test.** Anybody found in possession of such device, even in switched off mode, will be disqualified.
7. Please do not sign on the admit card before the test starts. You will be asked to sign on the admit card in presence of supervisor/invigilator.
8. Loss of the Admit Card must be reported immediately to the local Police Station and also to the Dean of Studies, ISI (**dean@isical.ac.in**). In such situation, the candidate is advised to proceed directly to the respective Admission Test Venue on the date of the Admission Test, and meet the Centre Supervisor along with the General Diary and one valid photo identity card (**Voter Id Card, Aadhar Card, Passport, Driving License, PAN Card, Identity Card issued by Educational Institute, etc.**) to prove his/her identity at the Venue.
9. **Please bring HB pencil, eraser and blue/black ink pen for the written test.**
10. On the OMR sheet, fill in the appropriate boxes and bubbles using pen (blue/black) or an **HB pencil as per instructions given there.**
11. The test will have a total of 50 questions carrying 150 marks. Each of these questions will be Multiple-Choice Question (MCQ). Every question has only one correct answer. Questions must be answered on the OMR sheet by shading the appropriate bubble using **ONLY an HB pencil** against the question number.
12. More than one answer bubbled against a question will be treated as wrong answer. Each correct answer to a question will result in three (03) marks, unattempted question will result in zero (0) mark and wrong answer to a question will result in minus one (-1) mark.

There is no direct bus service to Anna Adarsha College from Chennai Railway Station.

Go down the subway from central station and take bus route 15 / 15 B/15D. Ask for Anna Nagar Arch or NSK nagar (both are same) bus stop. Journey time is roughly 35 to 45 minutes. When you get down from the bus stop you should be able to see a huge arch spanning a road which leads to Anna Nagar. Take an auto rickshaw from there to reach Anna Adarsha Women College. Distance is 3 Km from the arch.
