

## Brief Biography of Sasthi C. Ghosh

He received the B.Sc. degree in Mathematics Honors from the University of Calcutta, Kolkata, India, in 1996, the Masters in Computer Application (M.C.A.) degree from the Jadavpur University, Kolkata, India, in 1999, and the Ph.D. degree in Computer Science from the Indian Statistical Institute, Kolkata, India, in 2004.
